- Purpose: to research and document the neighborhood's history

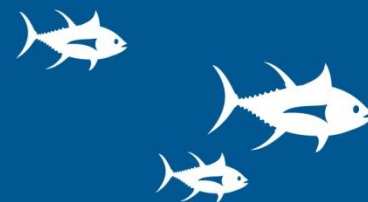

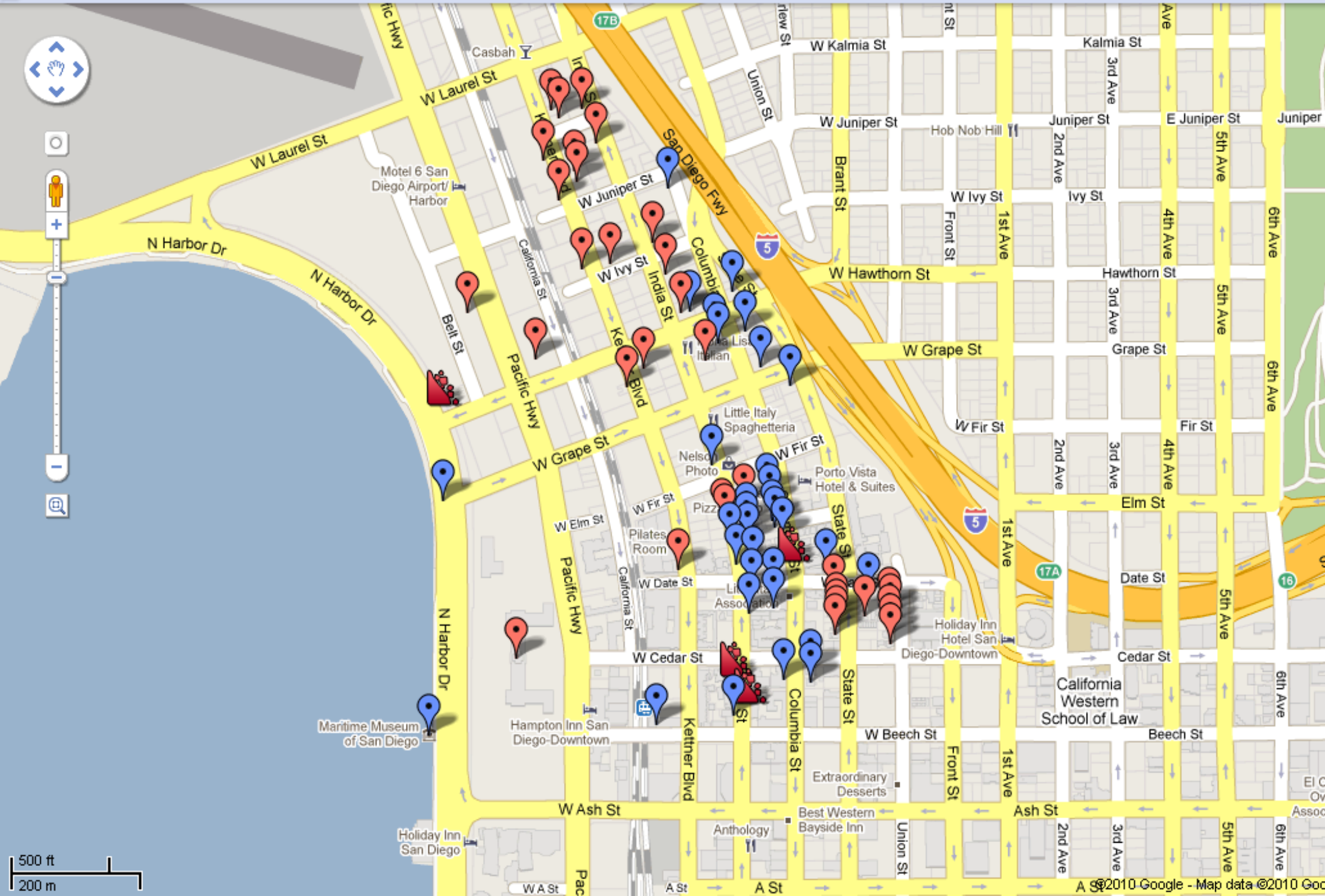
Themes and Stories

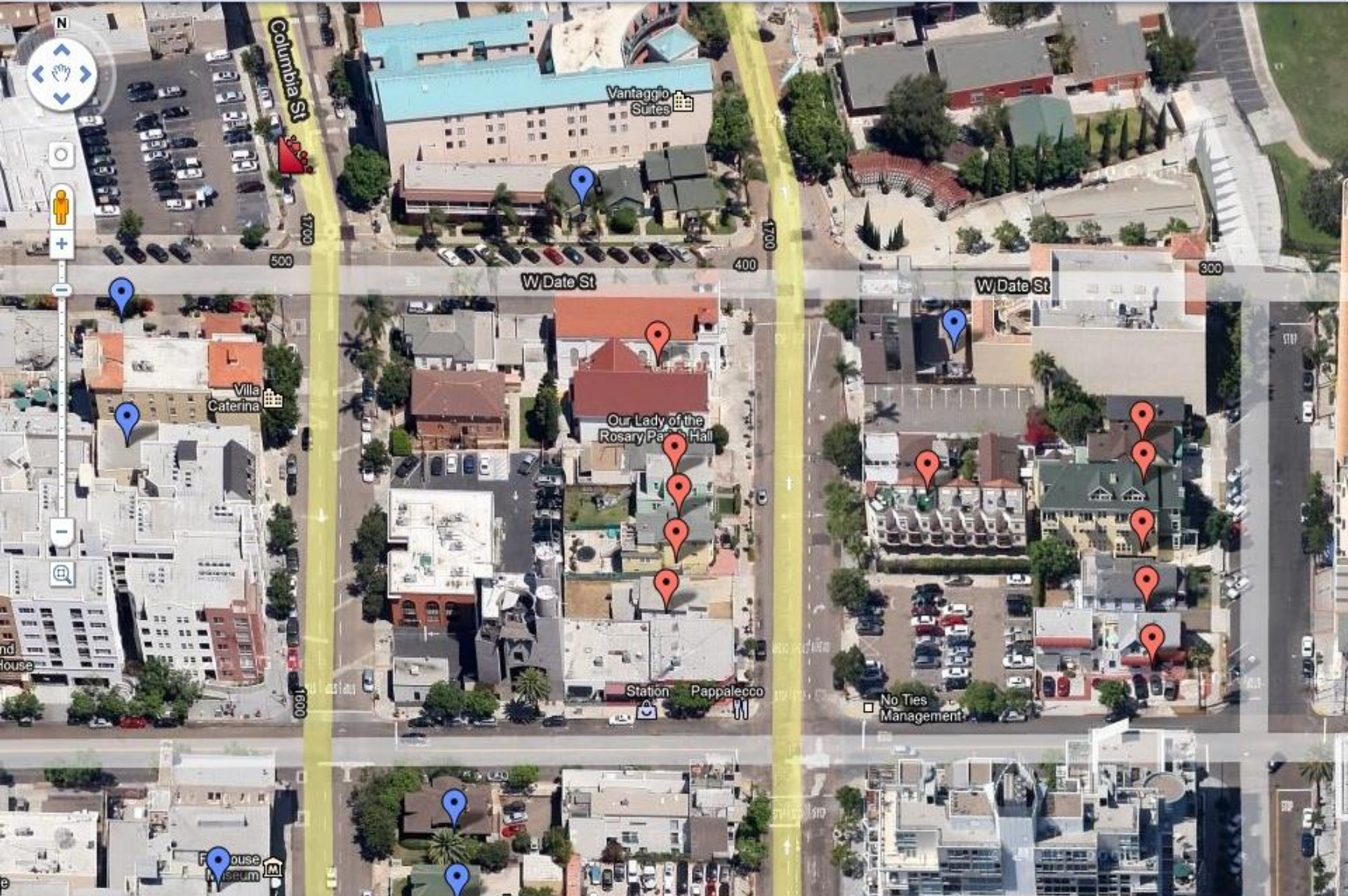

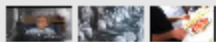

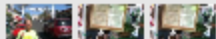
